The Pyjama Foundation (TPF) exists to **empower** and **support** vulnerable children living in **foster care**.

Its "Love of Learning Program" is a life-changing mentoring initiative that connects dedicated volunteers known as 'Pyjama Angels' with children in care.

TPF recruits, screens, and trains these compassionate individuals, ensuring they are thoughtfully matched with a child who can benefit most from their support.

Once a week, Pyjama Angels devote their time engaging in educational-based activities with their child, helping to instil a love for learning, building life skills and confidence.

The Pyjama Foundation aims to break the cycle of disadvantage experienced by children in care.

Through early intervention, support and mentoring, children in care are able to change their life trajectory.

About Kids In Care

These are the statistics The Pyjama Foundation is working hard to change.



There are more than 45,000 living in out of home care in Australia.

Young children, from newborn to 18-years-old are removed from their original homes when they are unable to live with their families, often due to child abuse, trauma and neglect - resulting in poor health and attachments.

This pool of children have the worst educational outcomes of any group of children in Australia.

We could host a morning tea.










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
